## Student Services



**Student Success** - We meet student needs using a variety of methods to ensure a successful and fulfilling high school experience. Student Success teachers are Ms. S. Ketcheson (ext. 43604) and Mr. D. Wilkey (ext. 43541). The office is located in room 110.

**Credit Recovery**- Students who were unsuccessful in gaining a credit at the end of the semester may be eligible to earn the credit through credit recovery. Students and/or their parents are encouraged to contact their Student Success Teacher for more details.

**Guidance** - The counsellors at Bear Creek can give information and support in areas related to careers, education and personal issues. Guidance is based on the premise that all individuals are unique and can make valuable contributions to society if given the opportunity to develop their own potential and abilities. **Special Education** - We meet the needs of exceptional students through a wide range of programs and services. These may include Resource teachers, strength and needs committee, guidance services, self-contained classes (life skills) and the regular classroom.

### Link Crew Program

A leadership and mentoring program which involves grade 11 and 12 students who help Grade 9 students make the transition into life at Bear Creek, through an orientation and other fun activities throughout the school year.
